

Giving Tuesday, is November 29 So We're Tooting our Horn! Please Support the Gulfport Senior Center Foundation This Month



Since 2008, the Gulfport Senior Center Foundation has been dedicated to raising and distributing funds to support and enhance health, educational, social and recreational programs and services of the Gulfport Multipurpose Senior Center.

The Foundation's proudest achievement is the installation and continuing maintenance of the **Senior Fitness Center**. In the past two years, two treadmills and a recumbent bicycle have been replaced.

This year, the Foundation received a \$5,000 grant from the Pinellas Community Foundation to implement a new service project to make available free **Hurricane Emergency Kits** for low-income local seniors. With assistance from the Senior Center, 60 kits were distributed including many items recommended by FEMA for hurricane survival, including a hand cranked/solar radio, first aid kit, plastic sheeting & duct tape, flashlights, manual can openers and more.

On September, 18, 2021, the Foundation celebrated installation of a new ceramic mural at the **Celebration Wall** just outside the Senior Center. Gulfport artist Brenda McMahon created and installed the 20-foot-long mural and Foundation supporters Kathleen and Frank Cash contributed to installation of the artwork and new lighting. Tiles may be purchased from the Foundation for display on the Celebration Wall to commemorate special events or remember loved ones. All proceeds will benefit the Foundation.

When the Senior Center's doors were closed due to the COVID pandemic, many classes and activities continued online. The Foundation pitched in by purchasing a video camera that is still used to continue the Center's online presence. When the facility reopened, the Foundation purchased a touch free water fountain and bottle filling station that was installed in the hallway between the Senior Center and the Catherine Hickman Theater.

Also ongoing is the Foundation's Gulfport Veterans Memorial Park paver project. The public is invited to purchase engraved pavers to honor service members and others. The meandering ribbon of pavers will become a permanent part of the park.

In 2020, the Foundation established an ongoing fund to keep Senior Center's Food Pantry well stocked, allowing the Center to distribute food on a regular basis to members of the Senior Center in need.
